Submissions must include a title, abstract, keywords, author(s) and affiliation(s) with postal and e-mail addresses. Note: If a submission is not accepted as a regular paper, it may be accepted as a "short paper". All accepted papers will be considered for the Best Paper Award. The paper must be registered on CMT by the deadline indicated below.

1. If you submit your paper for the SPRINGER, the paper must be prepared by using [the template](#) MS Word or LaTeX (12-15 pages) as a PDF file.
2. If you submit your paper for the ISPRS Archives, the paper must follow [Orange Book](#) format (Up to the 8 pages for Full Papers. 1000-1500 words for Extended Abstracts). Click [here](#) to see an example for Extended Abstract (Short Paper). Click [here](#) to see an example for Full Paper.
