#### OBJECTIVES

The workshop will include topics spanning classic problems in transportation and logistics, including network design problems, planning and control strategies, fleet management, routing, timetabling and vehicle scheduling, crew scheduling, real-time optimization of operational schemes, etc. These transportation problems can be formulated as mixed integer programs, considering deterministic and stochastic models that can be solved through sophisticated exact methods (for example branch and price for column generation schemes, branch and cut, etc.) and illustrated heuristics (such as evolutionary algorithms, GRASP methods, among others).
